

Research at the Framingham History Center

The research library is normally open on Thursdays, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., except for holidays, and by appointment. Inquiries can be addressed to research@framinghamhistory.org or by telephone at 508-872-3780.

The library does not lend materials, but in many cases selected materials can be reproduced and sent to individuals who cannot visit the library in person. Fees for services provided to patrons are as follows:
